

1 failed to truthfully answer question 8. Although he replied, "Yes" to question 8,
2 he only reported a 1968 arrest for DUII. A review of criminal history checks by
3 the State Department of Education shows that he had a September 1971
4 conviction for "Drunk" (in a public place) and "Indecent Exposure" (To Minors and
5 Adults), which he failed to disclose. He admitted to having been arrested and
6 pleading no contest to these charges in September 1971.

7
8 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

9 Donovan Earl Hampton's failure to report these convictions in response to
10 question 8 constitutes gross neglect of duty under ORS 342.175(1)(b) as it relates to
11 OAR 584-020-0040(4)(c) (*Knowing falsification of any document or knowing*
12 *misrepresentation directly related to licensure, employment, or professional duties.*) The
13 Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

14 **FINAL ORDER**

15 The Commission hereby revokes Donovan Earl Hampton's right to apply for an
16 Oregon educator license.
