

1 2. On May 24, 2009, Adamson became angry with a student who was not complying
2 with his instructions. Adamson pushed the student into a sitting positing outside the
3 classroom. In so doing Adamson shoved the student into the lockers in the hallway.

4 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

5 John David Adamson's conduct described in paragraph 2 above constitutes
6 gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it
7 incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), OAR 584-020-
8 0025(2)(a) (Establishing and maintaining classroom management that is conducive to
9 learning);and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(d) (*Unreasonable physical force against students,*
10 *fellow employees, or visitors to the school, except as permitted under ORS 339.250*).

11 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
12 ORS 342.175.

13 **FINAL ORDER**

14 The Commission hereby imposes a Public Reprimand on the licensure of John
15 David Adamson.
