

STIPULATION OF FACTS

1. The Commission has licensed Manning since May 10, 1996. Manning currently holds a Basic Teaching License, with an endorsement in Basic Advanced Mathematics, issued February 10, 2009 and valid through September 1, 2012. During all relevant times Manning worked for the Rainier School District.
2. On October 7, 2007 Manning was issued an Emergency Teaching License to allow her to complete the 2007/2008 school year.
3. Manning's Emergency Teaching License expired on June 30, 2008. The Commission received Manning's application for renewal on February 6, 2009.
4. During the time Manning's license was expired she taught in a charter school within the Rainer School District.
5. However, Manning had completed the 24 credit hours necessary for renewal of her Basic Teaching license before expiration of the Emergency Teaching License on June 30, 2008.





CONCLUSION OF LAW

Robin Ann Manning served without an active license from June 30, 2008, until February 10, 2009. This conduct constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(4)(r) (*Knowingly working without a license*) and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(2)(a) (*Apply for, accept, offer, or assign a position of responsibility only on the basis of professional qualifications, and will adhere to the conditions of a contract or the terms of the appointment*). The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.
