3 **STIPULATION OF FACTS**

4 1. The Commission has licensed Mr. Locke since July 1, 1974. Mr. Locke currently
5 holds a Standard Teaching License with an endorsement in Standard Integrated Science,
6 issued June 10, 2006 and valid through June 9, 2011. He was employed by the Portland Public
7 School District as a substitute teacher at all relevant times.

8 2. On December 12, 2008, while substituting at Clarendon-Portsmouth School, in the
9 Portland Public School District, Mr. Locke used a school district computer during his break time
10 to view sexually explicit materials. One sexually explicit image viewed by Mr. Locke was
11 inadvertently seen by a student later that day.

12 3. During an interview with a TSPC investigator Mr. Locke admitted this conduct. Mr.
13 Locke further admitted that over the last several years during other substitute assignments, he
14 accessed sexually explicit materials from school district computers on more than one occasion
15 during his break time.

22 **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

23 Fred E. Locke used school district computer equipment to access sexually explicit
24 materials. Mr. Locke's conduct caused a student to be exposed to this material. This conduct
25 constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(4)(q) and OAR 584-020-
26 0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5). The Commission's authority to
27 impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.
