

1 4. During the spring and fall of 2001, Mr. Brand failed to maintain accurate school
2 records for student under his responsibility by reporting certain students were attending school
3 when, in fact the students were absent and by giving students credit for school work that the
4 students had not completed.

5 5. On October 11, 2001, the school district placed Mr. Brand on administrative leave.
6 Subsequently he went on a medical leave, and he has not returned to the classroom. On
7 February 26, 2002, Mr. Brand resigned from his teaching position effective June 30, 2002, and
8 agreed to remain on unpaid leave for the remainder of the school year.

19 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

20 Mr. Brand violated OAR 584-020-0040(4)(c) by failing to maintain accurate student
21 records concerning attendance and course work. The Commission's authority to impose
22 discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175(1)(b).

23 **ORDER**

24 Donald Lee Brand's Standard Teaching License is suspended for a period of ninety (90)
25 days beginning on August 2, 2002. At the end of this suspension period, Mr. Brand's Teaching
26 License shall be reinstated upon submission of a complete application with required fees and
27 supporting documentation pursuant to OAR 584-050-0015(3).

28 Furthermore, the Commission imposes a two (2) year probation upon Donald Lee Brand
to commence on the date of reinstatement of licensure subject to the condition that Mr. Brand

1 comply with all Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance under Chapter 584, Division
2 020.


3 Violation of any of the terms of probation shall constitute an independent basis for the
4 Commission to revoke Mr. Brand's teaching license or otherwise impose discipline, after first
5 providing Mr. Brand's with notice and opportunity for hearing.
