

1 Thompson enters into this Stipulation of Facts with the knowledge that TSPC will adopt
2 an Order requiring the issuance of a public reprimand. This Stipulation is contingent upon the
3 approval and adoption of the Order by the Commission. If the Commission does not adopt this
4 Order, neither Thompson nor the Commission are bound by these stipulations and she retains all
5 rights to a hearing on the allegations.

16 Thompson engaged in inappropriate conduct with a student during instruction time on school
17 premises.
