

1 incident to her Principal immediately upon her return. On September 17, 2001, Mitchell School
2 Superintendent, Mike Carroll, reprimanded her for this behavior.

3 4. In November of 2000, during the Thanksgiving holiday weekend, Ms. Elsea
4 purchased a keg of beer for a party hosted by her sons (ages 18 and 21) in Bend, Oregon. Ms.
5 Elsea was aware that minors would consume the alcohol she purchased. Ms. Elsea admits to
6 furnishing the alcohol in exchange for a promise from her son that nobody would be permitted
7 to drink and drive during the weekend.

8 5. Ms. Elsea accepts responsibility for her behavior and acknowledges his behavior was
9 inappropriate.

10 This stipulation is contingent upon approval and adoption of the Order by the
11 Commission. If the Commission does not adopt this Order, neither Ms. Elsea nor the
12 Commission are bound by these Stipulations and Ms. Elsea retains all rights to a hearing on the
13 allegations.

22 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

23 By allowing minor students to consume alcohol in San Francisco Ms. Elsea violated
24 OAR 584-020-0040(4) Gross Neglect of Duty and California State Law. By furnishing alcohol to
25 minors in Bend, Oregon Ms. Elsea violated Oregon State Law and OAR 584-020-0040(5)(e)
26 Gross Unfitness.



ORDER


The Commission imposes a Public Reprimand on Ms. Elsea. This Stipulation of Facts and Order constitute the Reprimand.
