

1 Commission are bound by these Stipulations and Mr. Hampton retains all rights to a
2 hearing on the allegations.

3 **STIPULATION OF FACTS**

4 1. Mr. Hampton holds a Standard Administrative License valid until May 31,
5 2006, with Standard Superintendent and Standard Administrator Endorsements. The
6 Commission has continually licensed Mr. Hampton since June 1, 1969. The
7 Commission previously disciplined Mr. Hampton by Reprimand dated September 23,
8 1999.

9 2. On November 5, 2002, a school board member contacted Mr. Hampton in the
10 parking lot of the Sweet Home School District Office and invited him to take a look a
11 new rifle he received as a gift. Mr. Hampton took the unloaded rifle in hand, raised it to
12 his shoulder and looked through the scope.


13 3. Mr. Hampton accepts responsibility for his behavior and acknowledges that he

1 **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

2 On or about November 5, 2002, Mr. Hampton failed to use professional judgment
3 in violation of OAR 584-020-00010(5) when he handled and looked through the scope
4 of an unloaded rifle while standing on school district property. The Commission's
5 authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175(1)(b) .

6 **ORDER**

7 The Commission imposes a Public Reprimand on Mr. Hampton. This Stipulation
8 of Facts and Order of Reprimand constitute the reprimand.
