STIPULATION OF FACTS AND ORDER
REVOKING TEACHING LICENSE

6 On July 31, 2000, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) issued
7 a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Michael Dean Jager in which the Commission charged
8 Mr. Jager with misconduct and proposed to suspend, revoke or impose other discipline under
9 ORS 342.177. Mr. Jager and the Commission have now reviewed the matters alleged and have
10 agreed that their respective interests, together with the public interest are best served by a
11 stipulation to certain facts and a revocation of Mr. Jager's right to apply for reinstatement of his
12 teaching license. This agreement sets for the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the
13 Commission's order.

14 **STIPULATED FACTS**

15 1. Mr. Jager held a basic Oregon Teaching License from August 1988 until May 9,
16 2000, when the license expired. Mr. Jager does not hold a currently valid teaching license.

17 2. Mr. Jager was employed as a teacher for the Medford School District from 1988
18 until he resigned his position on about March 29, 1999.
