4 advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior
5 to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order
6 below.

7 **STIPULATION OF FACTS**

8 1. The Commission has licensed Lawrence Roy Crain since April 12, 1973. Mr. Crain
9 currently holds a Standard Teaching License valid October 28, 2004, through October 17, 2009, with
10 Basic Mathematics, Basic Spanish and Standard Language Arts Endorsements.

11 2. During Mr. Crain's 33 year history as a licensed educator in Oregon, prior to the events
12 giving rise to this order, the Commission has not received a complaint or a report regarding Mr. Crain.

13 3. Mr. Crain is employed by the Central Point School District as a Spanish teacher at Crater
14 High School. Mr. Crain has served as a teacher at Crater High School since 1985.

15 4. Mr. Crain failed to properly supervise the activities of students using his classroom
16 computer.

17 5. Mr. Crain transported a student in his personal vehicle to the coast in Brookings, Oregon in
18 June of 2005. This was not a school or educational related trip.

19 6. Mr. Crain purchased a laptop computer as a graduation gift in June of 2005 for the same
20 student.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

2 Lawrence Roy Crain violated OAR 584-020-0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-
3 0035(1)(c) by failing to maintain an appropriate professional student-teacher relationship with a
4 student attending Crater High School. This misconduct constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty. The
5 Commission has authority to impose discipline in this matter under ORS 342.120 through 342.430
6 and OAR Chapter 584.

ORDER

8 The Commission hereby adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
9 imposes a Public Reprimand on Lawrence Roy Crain. This Stipulation of Facts, Order and Probation
10 constitute the Reprimand.

11 Furthermore, the Commission imposes a two (2) year probation upon Mr. Crain requiring that
12 Mr. Crain comply with all Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance under Oregon
13 Administrative Rules, Chapter 584, Division 020.

14 Violation of the terms of this probation may constitute an independent basis for the
15 Commission to impose discipline, up to and including revocation of Mr. Crain's teaching license
16 subject to Mr. Crain's right to a hearing on the issue of whether he violated probation.
