2 Bargaining Agreement, Jack Walker's resignation letter, teacher's contract and the Board  
3 of Director's resolution requesting suspension of the teaching license of Jack Walker.

7 ULTIMATE FINDING OF FACT

9 Jack Walker resigned his teaching position with the Union-Baker Education Service District  
10 without providing 60 days' prior written notice to the district.  
11

12 CONCLUSION OF LAW  
13

14 Jack Walker violated ORS 342.553 by failing to provide 60 days' notice prior to resignation  
15 from his teaching position.

20 The Commission suspends the Oregon Basic Teaching License of Jack Morris Walker for the  
21 remainder of the 2002-03 school year.
