FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about June 25, 2002, Gary Stephen Wiese signed and submitted an Application for Educator License Form C-1 requesting renewal of his Standard Teaching License.

2. On or about June 25, 2002, Gary Stephen Wiese responded "no" to Character Question 7, "Have you ever been disciplined by any public agency responsible for licensure of any kind, including but not limited to educational licensure?"

3. Gary Stephen Wiese's response to character question 7 constitutes a false statement directly related to Licensure. The Commission adopted a Stipulation of Facts, Public Reprimand and Order in the matter of the Teaching License of Gary Stephen Wiese on January 19, 2000.

Gary Stephen Wiese made a false statement on his application for renewal of his teaching license. This action constitutes a basis for denial of licensure and discipline pursuant to ORS 342.175(1)(e), OAR 584-020-0040(4)(c), and OAR 584-050-0006(1).
