On or about June 1, 2001, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) received a report from Linda Borquist, Associate Superintendent, Beaverton School District, alleging that Jeffrey Kirk Johnson (Johnson) offered alcohol to a minor. The matter was investigated by the ^{Washington} ~~Clackamas~~ County Sheriff's Office. The ^{Washington} ~~Clackamas~~ County District Attorney did not file charges against Jeffery Johnson in this matter.

Mr. Johnson fully cooperated with the Commission's investigation. After review of the matters alleged, Mr. Johnson and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and the imposition of a Public Reprimand.

This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to be imposed. In entering into this stipulation, Mr. Johnson waives the right to a hearing to contest the finding of fact, conclusion of law and order set forth below.

This stipulation is contingent upon approval and adoption of the Order by the Commission. If the Commission does not adopt this Order, neither Mr. Johnson nor the Commission are bound by these Stipulations and Mr. Johnson retains all rights to a hearing on the allegations.

STIPULATION OF FACTS


1. Mr. Johnson holds a Transitional Teaching License valid October 10, 2000, through October 10, 2003, restricted to Beaverton School District. There are no previous complaints on file with the Commission. Mr. Johnson has not completed a teacher education program.

1 2. Mr. Johnson was employed by the Beaverton School District on a one-year, part-
2 time, temporary contract as a music instructor at the Arts & Communication High School for the
3 2000-2001 school year. Mr. Johnson has no prior teaching experience.


4 3. Mr. Johnson violated Beaverton School District policy during the 2000-2001 school
5 year by transporting female student, KM, in his personal vehicle, on multiple occasions.

6 4. Mr. Johnson accepts responsibility for his behavior and acknowledges that it was
7 inappropriate.

18 0040(4)(n), specifically OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) by violating District policy regarding the
19 transportation of a student.

20 **ORDER**

21 The Commission imposes a Public Reprimand on Mr. Johnson. This Stipulation of Facts
22 and Order of Reprimand constitute the reprimand.


Dear Susan:
