





1 ORS 342.125 or its substantial equivalent in another jurisdiction. ORS 342.175(2) and OAR  
2 584-020-0040(1).

3 The files and records in this case document that Mr. Wood possessed numerous computer  
4 images depicting children involved in sexual activity. It is apparent that Mr. Wood knew or  
5 should have known that photographing these activities involved child abuse.

6 Possession of such materials by a teacher also constitutes gross unfitness.

7 **ORDER**

8 The right of Landon James Wood to apply for an Oregon Teaching License is hereby  
9 revoked.


