



1 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

2 Mr. Heath's conviction in Idaho of Injury to a Child (I.C.18-150(1) a first degree felony sex  
3 offense is listed in ORS 342.143(3). The Commission is required to revoke Mr. Heath's right to apply  
4 for a license pursuant to ORS 342.175(2). The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this  
5 matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

6 **FINAL ORDER**

7 The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and conclusion of  
8 law, and hereby revokes Nathan Franz Heath's right to apply for a teaching license.
