

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Under ORS 342.175, the Commission is authorized to create Standards of Competent and Ethical Performance for Oregon Educators. By administrative rule the Commission has established that sexual advances and verbal or physical contact of a sexual nature directed towards a student constitutes sexual contact. Sexual contract is grounds for a finding of gross neglect duty. The commission also established that the harassment of another employee is grounds for a finding of gross neglect duty.

OPINION


Bradley J. Potter's behavior while employed by Jefferson School District indicates a lack of fitness to hold an Oregon teaching license. He received notice of the proposed action against his teaching license but did not request a hearing on the allegations.

ORDER

The Commission revokes the right of Bradley Jay Potter to reinstate his Oregon Teaching License #275564 issued August 4, 1993 to March 14, 1997,
