




1 2. Ms. Richards is employed as an elementary school teacher for the Salem-  
2 Keizer School District since August 26, 1997.

3 3. Ms. Richards reported that she was convicted on October 15, 2001, of  
4 Trespass in the Municipal Court of the City of Salem, County of Marion, State of Oregon  
5 (case #00-655760). The Court ordered imposition of sentence suspended and placed  
6 her on probation for two years. Ms. Richards was assessed \$285 in fines.

7 4. Ms. Richards has no prior or subsequent criminal convictions.

8 This stipulation is contingent upon approval and adoption of the Order by the  
9 Commission. If the Commission does not adopt this Order, neither Ms. Richards nor  
10 the Commission are bound by these Stipulations and Ms. Richards retains all rights to a  
11 hearing on the allegations.

19 **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

20 Ms. Richards' conviction for Trespass, constitutes Gross Unfitness as defined in  
21 OAR 580-020-0040(5)(c). The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this  
22 matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

23 **ORDER**

24 The Commission adopts the above Stipulation of Facts and imposes a Public  
25 Reprimand for conviction of Trespass. This Order shall serve as the Public Reprimand.

1 The Commission authorizes issuance of licensure to Ms. Richards subject to all  
2 standard terms, conditions, endorsements or authorization thereon.
