- 2 1. The Commission has licensed Mr. Deen since October 11, 2002. Mr. Deen currently  
3 holds an Initial II Teaching License, with an endorsement in Multiple Subjects, issued  
4 July 30, 2006 and valid through July 29, 2009. Mr. Deen submitted an application on  
5 July 23, 2009 to renew his license.
- 6 2. In the spring of 2004, while employed by the Jackson County School District, Mr. Deen's  
7 principal gave Mr. Deen her computer password so that he could use it for educational  
8 purposes. In or around February of 2007, while employed by the Jackson County  
9 School District, Mr. Deen used the principal's password to access the principal's email  
10 and other confidential information without consent.

23 as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(2)(e) (*Not use the district's or school's name, property, or*  
24 *resources for noneducational benefit or purposes without approval of the educator's supervisor*  
25 *or the appointing authority*)
