**STIPULATION OF FACTS AND
FINAL ORDER OF REPRIMAND**

On or about August 4, 2010, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) received a report from the Superintendent of the Scio School District indicating that Stacy Dawn McAllister (McAllister) may have failed to report a possible case of child abuse in a timely manner.

After review of the matters alleged, McAllister and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and the imposition of a Public Reprimand on McAllister's Initial I Teaching License.



By signing below, McAllister acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) she has been fully advised of her rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Reprimand (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request to the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither McAllister nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) she has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) she voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) she states that no promise or representation has been made to induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) she has

1 consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully
2 advised with regard to her rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an
3 attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of
4 the Stipulated Final Order below.

5 **STIPULATION OF FACTS**

- 6 1. The Commission has licensed Stacy Dawn McAllister as a teacher in Oregon since
7 June 19, 2007. McAllister's current Initial I Teaching License, with an endorsement
8 in Multiple Subjects Self Contained (ECE, ELE), issued on January 17, 2010, is valid
9 until January 3, 2012. During all relevant times, McAllister was employed by the
10 Scio School District.
- 11 2. On March 12, 2010, McAllister overheard several female first grade students,
12 including AB, discussing the manner in which AB's father treated her and hoping
13 that the father would treat her more nicely. On March 15, 2010, McAllister spoke
14 with a parent of one of the girls who reported to McAllister that AB had disclosed
15 that her father spansks her with a belt, drives erratically, and grabs her by the hand.
16 On March 19, 2010, McAllister was contacted by the father of a student who reported
17 that his daughter related that AB's father pulls her hair and pushes her down, is
18 trained to hurt people and would hurt his daughter's parents. On March 23, 2010,
19 you addressed the issues with AB's father and mother directly. You did not report
20 this information to DHS until March 29, 2010.

29 **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

30 Stacy Dawn McAllister did not immediately report her concerns of potential child abuse.
31 This conduct constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-
32 0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*) and OAR
33 584-020-0040(4)(s) (*Failing to report child abuse pursuant to ORS 419B.010*).
