



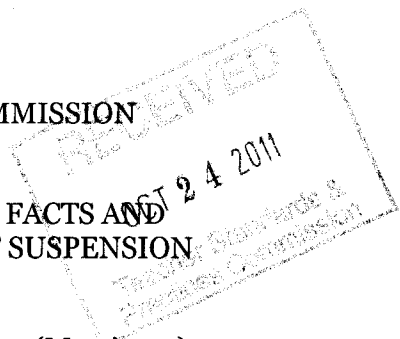

JORDAN KYLE MASSINGER )



On May 1, 2009, the Commission referred Jordan Kyle Massinger (Massinger), to investigation for teaching without a License or Charter School Registry.

After review of the matters alleged, Massinger and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and the imposition of a 30 day suspension of his license.


By signing below, Massinger acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Suspension (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Massinger nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below.

**STIPULATION OF FACTS**


1. Jordan Kyle Massinger has held a Charter School Registry since August 25, 2009. Massinger's current Charter School Registry issued on August 25, 2009, expires on August 25, 2012. During all relevant times Massinger was employed by the Arthur Academy Public Charter School
2. On November 28, 2008, the Commission received Massinger's application for a Charter School Registry.

- a. On December 26, 2008, the Commission sent an incomplete notice to Massinger and Arthur Academy requesting a fingerprint card for criminal history verification.
  - b. On April 13, 2009, the requested fingerprint card was received by the Commission.
  - c. On April 30, 2009, the Commission sent Massinger a new incomplete notice, requested a new letter from Arthur Academy requesting registry for Massinger, and a letter of explanation whether Massinger was employed prior to receiving his Charter School Registry.
  - d. On May 29, 2009, the Commission sent another incomplete notice to Massinger and Arthur Academy requesting the same information.
  - e. On June 19, 2009, the Commission received a letter from Arthur Academy indicating that Massinger had been hired to teach 4<sup>th</sup> grade at the school and requesting Massinger's registry.
  - f. On August 17, 2009, the Commission sent Massinger and Arthur Academy another incomplete notice, again requesting a new letter requesting the registry and explaining why Massinger was allowed to teach without a registry.
  - g. On August 20, 2009, the Commission received a letter from Arthur Academy indicating that Massinger had taught at the charter school beginning in the 2008/2009 school year and would be teaching the following year.
  - h. On December 22, 2009, the Commission received a phone call from the Arthur Academy requesting Massinger's registry and explaining problems with office staff that led to delays in properly responding.
3. Massinger's Charter School Registry was issued in December of 2009, effective the beginning of the 2009/2010 school year. During the 2008/2009 school year Massinger taught at the Arthur Academy without a Charter School Registry, despite receiving multiple notices.

**CONCLUSION OF LAW**

Jordan Kyle Massinger taught at the Arthur Academy without a Charter School Registry, despite receiving multiple notices, during the 2008/2009 school year. This conduct constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(r) (*Knowingly working without a license*).

The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

**ORDER**

Based on the foregoing, the Commission hereby orders that Jordan Kyle Massinger's Charter School Registration is hereby suspended for a period of 30 days.
