

FINDINGS OF FACT

1
2 1. Ms. Cockrell holds a Basic Teaching License issued July 15, 2002, valid until
3 August 7, 2005.

4 2. Ms. Cockrell served as a teacher for the Archdiocese of Portland.

5 3. On January 27, 2004, Anne Marie Cockrell was convicted of Child Neglect 1,
6 ORS 163.547, and Possession of Controlled Substance 1, ORS 475.9924A, in the
7 Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Multnomah.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8
9 The crime of Child Neglect 1 as defined in ORS 163.547 is listed in ORS
10 342.143(3). The Commission is required to revoke the Oregon Basic Teaching License
11 issued to Anne Marie Cockrell and revoke her right to apply for a license pursuant to
12 ORS 342.175(2).
