

OPINION

Mr. Metteer's behavior reflects poor professional judgment and lack of respect for students. The sanctions imposed for his behavior are based upon the belief that he is capable of improved performance and should be entitled to a second chance following a period of suspension of license.

ORDER

The Commission suspends for one year the Oregon Substitute Teaching License #211674, issued to Robert E. Metteer, Jr. On or after March 13, 1999, Mr. Metteer shall be entitled to reinstatement of his Oregon teaching license upon receipt of a complete application. However, he shall be on probation for two years from the date of reinstatement. During this period of probation Metteer shall conduct himself as a law-abiding citizen and shall comply with the Standards of Competent and Ethical Performance of Oregon Educators.


