CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Ms. Sauvajon's conviction of Endangering the Welfare of a Minor, ORS 163.575 is listed in
3 ORS 342.143(3). The Commission is required to revoke the Initial Teaching License issued to
4 Ms. Sauvajon and revoke her right to apply for a license pursuant to ORS 342.175(2).

5 Ms. Sauvajon's conviction for Furnishing Alcohol to a Person Under 21 Years of Age, ORS
6 471.410 constitutes Gross Unfitness as defined in OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c). The Commission's
7 authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

ORDER

9 The Commission hereby revokes the Initial Teaching License issued to Brandye Noelle
10 Sauvajon and revokes her right to apply for a teaching license.


